








(I knew I should have run to that wall first, Lol!)





I had about 9 pounds, but Jimmy had between 13-14 lbs. from the back of the boat. Jimmy had two largemouth and one spot over 3 lbs. with a handful fish in the 2.5 lb. range.



Other than his new "PB" Spot, Ken had a rough night Wednesday as he found his trailer tire shredded to pieces when he went to recover his boat @ 12:30 AM. Ken said he never felt anything odd when traveling to the lake, but obviously he had been driving on what was left of the tire for a while. Ken said he threw a senko in 5-10 feet of water with the best bite for the quality fish being between 10:30 and 11:00 PM. He said he caught three good ones during that little flurry. Great job Ken!

Second place went to Jeff Short who continues to lead the Angler of the Year race. Jeff fished upriver, above trimmer, in the standing timber. Jeff was throwing a square bill crank bait around wood and had his limit before dark. He culled one fish on a spinnerbait at about 10:30 a brought in a limit for 12.30 anchored by two 3.41 lb. spots. Way to go Jeff!



Third place went to Tim "I finally got a bite in a damn tournament" Turner! Tim had gone two-night tournaments in a row without getting a bite. That changed this month when Tim weighed in an 11.65 lb. limit anchored by the tournament big fish of 5.08 lbs. Tim said he fished the main lake all night long. He caught the 5.08 spot, at about 7:45 on a crank bait. He caught his remaining fish on a senko. Tim also broke the five-pound limit for the progressive big fish pot. It will be a nice payday for him. What a fattie! (Not Tim)




Rounding out the top five was AJ Dunkin with a 9.32 lb. limit and Chris Tamez with a 7.64 lb. limit.
