

Lake Don Pedro Spring 2022



FRESNO BASS CLUB MEMBERS,

The third stop for the 2022 Fresno Bass Club were the clear waters of Lake Don Pedro, a well-known motherlode lake full of big fat bass. At times it can take upwards of 30+ pounds for a five fish limit to win here and all of us hoped that would be the case this year!

Low water and extreme fluctuations in the weather had the bass spinning and in turn gave most of us a headache wondering where the big bass had gone. It was rumored that one angler pre-fishing for another tournament during the week had over 30 pounds one day and over 26 pounds another day, but even he struggled as the conditions changed and so did the bass.

Bass were not difficult to catch, but anything over 2 pounds was a bonus. For example, Jimmy Arnold and I had 15 pounds on Thursday, 13 pounds on Friday, 9.84 on Saturday and 9.55 on Sunday. I don't know what changed, but our bite took a dump.

In addition, the progressive big fish pot was at stake and normally a fish over 5 pounds at the Don Pedro Tournament is a given, but not this year. The progressive big fish was never caught which means the progressive pot will roll over to the April tournament at the California Delta. I'm sure the progressive pot won't make it past the April tournament on the Delta so get ready!

Ok, so this is going to be short and sweet this month as I have been buried in work and I'm getting ready to leave on Thursday for the Bass Nation tournament at Tulloch.

Even though conditions were tough for most, there are always a few guys that do a little something different or find an area loaded with bass.

This month's winner was Jessie Perez Sr. Jessie and Jose Guzman who were both neck and neck after weighing in Day 1 bags over 13 pounds, but on Day 2, Jessie was the only one to keep catching decent fish. Jessie's two-day total was 23.51 pounds and enough for the win!

Jessie said he caught all his fish on a Pro worm's Purple Death with red flake on a darter head on the main lake. Congratulations Jessie!



Second place went Lazar Calderon who had a little bit of a rough day on Day 1. Lazar said he sight fished on Day 1 landing only small bed fish in the Big Creek area. On Day 2, Lazar said he just went fishing an abandoned the sight fishing. That ended up being a great move, not only did Lazar weigh-in the biggest bag of Day 2 @ 12.75 lbs., but that was enough for a total of 22.19 pounds and securing himself a narrow second place finish. Great job Lazar!!



Third place went the always consistent Jose Guzman. Jose said he caught his fish throwing a drop shot tipped with a Roboworm "Alive Shad" in hologram shad on the main lake both days. Jose's two-day total tipped the scaled at 22.01 lbs. and enough to hang onto a top three finish. Way to go "Cold fingers!"



Rounding out the top five were Seth Rowe in fourth place with 4th place with 19.51 and Bill Rowles Sr. in 5th place with 18.75. Way to go guys!




