

# Lake McClure Tournament



# FRESNO BASS CLUB MEMBERS,

Lake McClure, the lake I used to call one of my favorite lakes, bit me in the A@\$ this month. The word on the street was the jig bite was red hot and a guy could catch 50 fish a day without even trying. Well, at least that was the case while pre-fishing during the week. The club members who had the opportunity to pre-fish during the week had great success in both numbers and size, but by the time the weekend and tournaments rolled around the fish became a little more finicky and did the ole "switcharoo"!

Pre-fishing for Jimmy Arnold and I was decent on Friday in terms of numbers and quality. The jig bite was on fire as advertised and the numbers were good as well. We started out throwing jigs in 35-40 feet catching fish on almost every cast until the sun came up.

As the day progressed and the fish moved shallower for us each day and by noon the largemouth were cruising the banks. On Friday and Saturday, we would go to the bank starting about noon and found quality largemouth in both Cottonwood and Temperance, but of course on tournament day I waited them out shallow and they never showed which led to a horrible finish!



This four-pound pre-fishing largemouth was caught by Jimmy Arnold in less than a foot of water on a drop-shot.

This month's champion of champions is none other than Ted "El Presidente" Taylor! Ted caught a five fish limit, including the tournament big fish of 5.03, for butt kicking total of 11.18 lbs. Ted's closest competitor was nearly 2.5 pounds behind him. Ted said he caught most of his fish on a jerk-bait early including the 5.03. After that he caught a couple on an underspin then nothing but smaller fish the rest of the day. Congratulations Ted!



Second place this month went to Mark Corrente, who once again just showed up and went fishing. Mark sat on his primary spot for a few hours only catching three fish. After that Mark moved around fishing isolated rock piles on the main lake stating the bite got better for him in the afternoon. Mark fished Pro Worms (Pro Gold and Peoples Worm) in 5-45 feet. Mark's five fish limit weighed in at 8.73 lbs. and good enough for second place.



Third place went to John Albidrez. John fished main lake rock piles in the middle of the houseboats. John had pre-fished this area, but confirmed his findings when 2<sup>nd</sup> place, and big fish came off this spot during Saturdays Sierra Club Tournament. He knew this area was producing and stuck with it pretty much all-day fishing 30-45 feet. John's fish weighed 8.60. Way to go John!



Fourth place went to the ever-consistent Ken Eddy (I forgot the bananas). Ken was fishing 45-degree banks in 5-15 feet in the morning then culled a few out in the afternoon in 35-50 feet. Ken's weapon of choice was his Creekside Sculpin Lite with a cinnamon black flake twin tail grub. Ken's fish weighed 8.20 lbs. Great job Ken!



Rounding out the top five was Tim Turner another guy who just showed up and fished on Sunday. Tim started out the day chucking and winding a spinnerbait and fishing Pro Worms on the main lake in 5-15 feet of water. Tim said his pattern lasted until about noon. Tim ended up with one dead fish that cost him fourth place. With his half pound deduction, Tim's five fish weighed 8.08 pushing down to fifth place.
